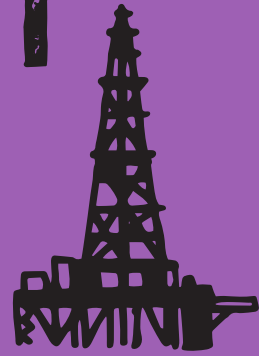

## ROTARY DRILL OPERATOR

A rotary drill operator in the Energy industry is someone who sets up or operates a variety of drills to remove underground oil and gas, or remove core samples for testing during oil and gas exploration. A person working as a rotary drill operator has good attention to detail to determine locations, angles, and depths of blast holes using measuring devices. You can become a rotary drill operator by earning a high school diploma.

Essential skills for the career include:

- Ability to assemble detonation units for construction or extraction work
- Strength to operate heavy equipment
- Operation monitoring to ensure machines are working properly
